

Hawkesbury Road Widening

Westmead Precinct - May Update



COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's major public transport projects, part of a record \$89.7 billion infrastructure investment across the state. Stage 1 of Parramatta Light Rail will connect Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia, and is due to open in 2023.

Hawkesbury Road between Darcy Road and Jessie Street is being widened in preparation for the construction and operation of Parramatta Light Rail and the Westmead Redevelopment project. The contractor Ford Civil has been engaged to carry out this work.

Upcoming Minor Works

In May 2019, work on Hawkesbury Road between the south of Darcy Road and Jessie Street will involve:

- establishing new footpaths
- establishing a temporary pedestrian crossing at the Westmead Institute for Medical Research
- targeted excavations in the road and footpath to identify underground services and utilities
- installation of new Telstra conduits
- reinstating footpath and road surfaces for safe access.

These works will take four weeks to complete, weather permitting. See overleaf for map and locations of work.

When will the work take place?

Standard construction hours will be **7am to 7pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 6pm on Saturday**.

Traffic and Pedestrian Access

Temporary pedestrian and traffic control will be in place to ensure traffic, cyclists and pedestrians can move around the work zones safely. Works will occupy portions of the parking lanes along Hawkesbury Road, and removed parking will be reinstated upon completion. Some parking will be permanently removed to install the temporary pedestrian crossing at the Westmead Institute of Medical Research. Works have been staged to minimise impact on parking along Hawkesbury Road. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times.

Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs, and proceed carefully.

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, road saws, jackhammers, compactors, excavators, vacuum trucks, forklift, light vehicles and power tools.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and vibration associated with this work. We understand our work may be disruptive and we apologise for the inconvenience. We will make every effort to minimise noise and vibration by:

- providing respite periods if undertaking any high-level noise activities
- monitoring and reviewing noise levels
- consulting directly with affected residents and businesses
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- directing noise emissions away from businesses and residential properties, where possible
