



Key Dates

The Westmead Redevelopment is helping to create a transport solution that builds a more accessible, liveable and workable precinct.

By about 2035, we expect 25,000 people everyday to be working at and visiting Westmead, so we need a long-term sustainable solution for access, traffic and transport.

The long term plan for the Westmead Redevelopment is to ease parking stress by creating new car parking, working with Government to improve public transport and improving existing parking areas, roads and wayfinding.

Car parking

In February 2015, the NSW government announced \$72 million for hospital parking.

This includes more than 1400 additional spaces across the Westmead precinct, a new multi deck car park, a new modern car park management system for the precinct, as well as better security, improved lighting, footpaths and CCTV.

Construction of the new multi deck car park will commence in mid 2016 and is due for completion in mid 2017.

It is important to note that there will be no net loss in car parking at Westmead during the Westmead Redevelopment. The car parks opening in March 2016 will be to cover other spaces taken to maintain existing parking.

Our approach to car parking recognises the needs of staff, patients, carers visitors, emergency vehicles and on-call staff.

Light Rail

On 8 December 2015, the NSW Premier Mike Baird announced the preferred route for the Parramatta Light Rail project. The spine of the preferred route runs from Westmead to Strathfield via Parramatta CBD, incorporating Camellia and Sydney Olympic Park. A light rail line will also branch to Carlingford, replacing the existing heavy rail shuttle.

The NSW Government is committed to developing the Parramatta Light Rail project as quickly as possible. A project team has been assembled and detailed design work for the preferred network has commenced. Transport for NSW expects construction to commence in late 2018, subject to planning approval.

- The first car parking changes will be occurring in 2016.
- The Westmead Hospital Multi-Deck car park will begin construction in mid 2016 to be completed in 2017.
- Construction of the Parramatta light rail network is expected to commence in 2018.
