Westmead Hospital stage 1 overview

The Westmead Hospital refurbishment program is transforming more than 30 per cent of clinical areas between 2017 and 2022. Stage 1 of the program has been completed. Planning and design is underway for stage 2, with construction set to start soon.

Stage 1 projects completed include:

- A new 16-bed gastroenterology ward in A3a and the Gastroenterology Day Centre - the first part of a two-stage refurbishment
- A new ear, nose and throat (ENT) and audiology unit in E2
- A new 64-bed inpatient unit in B6 for patients recovering from a range of surgical procedures including orthopaedics, vascular, ENT, plastics, head and neck, colorectal and upper gastrointestinal procedures
- The O3Hub - Westmead's first activity-based working space for finance, clinical governance and procurement




Westmead Education and Conference Centre (WECC) level 1 was extensively refurbished and opened in September 2017.

Education spaces

The Westmead Education and Conference Centre (WECC), located within Westmead Hospital, was refurbished by the University of Sydney in partnership with WSLHD. The University's investment in the WECC has seen Level 1 transformed into a new, highly engaging teaching and learning environment, while level 2 was refurbished with new flooring and lighting.


In another collaboration project with the University of Sydney and the WSLHD, the Westmead Hospital Library is in its final stages of refurbishment, revealing an exciting new light filled, technology enabled fresh studying and learning space. The Library will be open to the public mid-June 2018.

Kids Research

Kids Research completed a two stage refurbishment, which included new collaborative work and meeting areas, staff office accommodation and a new [Clinical Research Centre](#).



Westmead Hospital's gastroenterology was refurbished during stage 1. The stage 2 refurbishment is underway to extend their space.

Westmead Hospital refurbishment program - stage 2

Planning and design for stage 2 of the refurbishment program is underway.

This includes:

- Intensive Care Unit (ICU) expansion (D3) and admin (E3)
- Gastroenterology Comprehensive Care Centre expansion (A3c)
- Aged Care expansion, including a new behavioural management unit (D4c)
- Loading dock
- Transit Lounge expansion (G1)
- Refurbishment of the Western Sydney Local Health District clinical support and executive offices (E2) to implement activity-based working principles

WSLHD projects

In 2017, Western Sydney Local Health District (WSLHD)'s Capital Works team undertook a range of refurbishments including a new communications room, the installation of two new MRI machines and a new linear accelerator. [Read a summary of the 2016-2017 works.](#)
