**As the end of 2023 approaches we reflect on the huge year we've had in Redevelopment!**

In February 2023 we celebrated the official opening of the 12-storey Clinical Services Building, the centrepiece of the \$632 million Stage 2 of the

hospital's redevelopment, bringing world-class healthcare to the growing Macarthur region. The new building positions Campbelltown Hospital to provide safe, high-quality health services for our community well into the future.

Earlier this year our pioneering design work was recognised through the Billard Leece Partnership receiving top accolades for Mental Health and Interior Design and The Arts at the European Healthcare Awards.

The Campbelltown Hospital Redevelopment was celebrated for its visionary design and patient-centric spaces, integrating six-storeys of mental health services with thoughtful incorporation of art as a healing environment.

Campbelltown Hospital was also proud to be selected as a finalist for Project of the Year at this year's National Infrastructure Awards. Hosted by Infrastructure Partnerships Australia, the national

awards recognise and celebrate excellence in project delivery and individual achievement across the infrastructure sector.

Rounding out the year, the team was honoured to be recognised for its Arts and Culture Strategy, winning the award for Enhancing Patients' Experience Through Arts award at the 2023 South Western Sydney Local Health District Quality Awards. The award recognised the integration of the arts across a wide range of clinical and non-clinical settings on campus.
