## Campbelltown Hospital Redevelopment

## New northern entrance has peaceful backdrop





The \$632 million Stage 2 Campbelltown Hospital redevelopment has achieved a major milestone with the opening of the facility's new northern entrance.

The northern entrance and its surrounding landscaping are the last major works delivered as part of the redevelopment.

Hospital General Manager Grant Isedale said the new entry point offered patients, staff and the community convenient access from the northern side of the campus.

"It links directly with the main concourse of the hospital, known as Hospital Street, allowing patients, staff and visitors easy and quick access to services and care areas," Mr Isedale said.

"The new entrance is the last major works for the redevelopment project, which is now almost completed.

"We are so proud of our contemporary new hospital building. It is delivering outstanding care to our community, close to home."

The beautifully landscaped green space outside the new entrance includes more than 4000 plants, mostly native species, 12,000 square metres of turf, and covered seating areas, ideal for rest and relaxation.

Closest parking areas for the community are P8. P9 and P10.
