Introducing the new Campbelltown Hospital building


The NSW Government has invested more than \$632 million in the Stage 2 redevelopment of Campbelltown Hospital, providing a major expansion and upgrade of essential health services for the Macarthur community.

The new 12-storey clinical services building includes a new Emergency Department and provides a range of enhanced clinical services, with capacity to further expand to meet future demand.

The new building boasts state-of-the-art operating theatres, enhanced Intensive Care Unit, new inpatient units, expanded women's and children's services, along with expanded and centralised mental health services.



*Services will move into the new building in stages between June to August 2022.



The new Campbelltown Hospital building opens in stages from early June 2022.

The new building will include the main hospital entrance, Emergency Department (ED), along with a range of enhanced and expanded hospital services.

There will be changes to the way you access some services at Campbelltown Hospital:

- Building names will change (refer to campus map)
- The new building will be known as Building A
- A new public car park (P3) and hospital campus road will mean changes to patient drop-off zones and public transport routes. Accessible parking options are available.

How to get to the new Emergency Department

From late June 2022, the new ED will be located on Level 0 of the new Building A. The dedicated ED patient drop-off zone and P1 car park are best accessed via Central Road.

How to get to the new main entrance

Access the Building A new main entrance off Therry Road. Best parking is P2 or P3, or off Central Road for the drop-off/pick-up zone in front of the new building.

The hospital bus stop is now located outside the new main entrance near the drop-off zone.

Need help finding your way? Visit the Main Reception desk in Building A, Level 2 near the main entrance.

Please read your appointment letter carefully. It has information about the most suitable parking area, drop-off zone and building entry.
