

CAMPBELLTOWN HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT

APPIN ROAD ENTRY WORKS

INFORMATION SHEET | JULY 2021

Works are now underway to construct a new campus entry driveway off Appin Road, adjacent to the P4 car park.

The relocated entry point will provide easier access to the new hospital building currently under construction, and will replace the existing Appin Road entry in early 2022.

To ensure works are completed in time to support the opening of the new clinical services building, works will occur 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and are scheduled to continue until late February 2021.

You may notice some noise, dust, vibration and an increase in construction vehicles at varying times within and around the work area.

A traffic control plan will keep everyone safe, with road work signs and traffic controllers in place to make navigating around the works as easy as possible. As always, emergency vehicles will have right of way.

We understand works can be disruptive, and all effort will be made to minimise the impact to hospital users and surrounding residents.
