BUILDING REMOVAL

INFORMATION SHEET | OCTOBER 2022

From October 2022, you may notice an increase of dust, noise, vibration and construction traffic around the Campbelltown Hospital campus, as decommissioning works commence on Building C, Gna Ka Lun and Waratah House.

As part of the final works for the \$632 million Stage 2 redevelopment at Campbelltown Hospital, a range of refurbishments and landscaping will occur until late 2023.

You may notice an increase of dust, noise, vibration, and construction traffic, while our builders set up their work site and begin the decommissioning of Building C, Gna Ka Lun and Waratah House.
